### **BISHOP NEIL C. ELLIS**

**Bishop Ellis organized Mount Tabor Union Baptist Church in February of 1987 with thirteen members. Mount Tabor (now Full Gospel Baptist Church), is one of the fastest growing churches in The Bahamas; and over the years the Ministry has emerged as the largest body of believers in the country. With a membership of more than 7,000; the life-changing messages delivered by Bishop Ellis are regularly quoted throughout the country and in the country's House of Parliament.**

**Bishop Ellis has been involved in the Full Gospel Baptist Church Fellowship International since its inception and on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1995 where he was consecrated as Bishop of Foreign Ministries. Bishop Ellis' diligence and commitment to the Fellowship has resulted in his serving in numerous capacities. He has served as the first Regional Bishop for the Bahamas, the first Bishop of Foreign Ministry, the first Chairman of the College of Bishops; as 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant to The International Presiding Bishop and 3<sup>rd</sup> International Presiding Bishop. He presently serves as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Presiding Bishop of the International Fellowship and Chairman of the Full Gospel Denomination in the Bahamas. He holds an Honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from both St. Thomas Christian College and Virginia Theological Seminary and College.**

**In 2004, Bishop Ellis was honored by Civil Society as a "Living Legend" in The Bahamas. In November 2005, Bishop Ellis received one of the highest honors of the Commonwealth, the CMG (Companion of St. Michael and St. George). The most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George is a British order of chivalry founded in 1818 by George, Prince of Wales. It is used by the British Monarchy (Her Majesty, The Queen of England) to honor individuals who have rendered distinguished services in Commonwealth nations.**

**Along with the obvious anointing of the Holy Spirit upon his life, Bishop Ellis is a pastor's pastor and a preacher's preacher that mentors some 40 pastors in the Bahamas and throughout the United States. He is passionate about the Word of God and its ability to transform lives. A much sought after preacher, Bishop Ellis has carried the gospel throughout the Bahamas, the Caribbean, North America, Germany, Africa, Israel, Greece and Rome.**

**His fresh style of ministry and the profound yet practical books that he has authored often challenges motivates and inspires the readers.**

**Bishop Ellis resides in Nassau, Bahamas with his wife Patrice and their two children.**
